Preamble

This Chronicle is a genealogical and archival record of the House of Svinar, created to preserve the memory of the origin, continuity, and history of the lineage for present and future generations.

It records family tradition, ancestral memory, symbolic continuity, and the stated account of the origin of the Svinar lineage, while distinguishing historically verifiable information from tradition and reconstruction.

The Chronicle does not replace civil-status records, archival evidence, judicial decisions, or a professional genealogical conclusion, and does not in itself create a noble, princely, or other public-law title. Its strength lies in the preservation of memory, the continuity of sources, and responsibility toward future generations.

1. Lineage and Family Tradition

Within the family tradition of the Svinar lineage, an account has been preserved tracing the line to the Princes Svirsky. Historical information concerning the Svirsky family belongs to the East European historical sphere; however, a specific and uninterrupted genealogical chain from historical members of the Svirsky family to the present-day Svinar family requires independent confirmation through primary archival sources.

According to family memory passed down through generations, the change of surname is associated with periods of war, social upheaval, persecution, and the need to preserve the family. The Chronicle preserves this account as family tradition until individual links in the lineage are confirmed by parish registers, civil-status records, confessional registers, censuses, military, land, judicial, or other archival materials.

The Chronicle does not declare the unproven to be proven. It preserves the family account of origin and establishes a principle: the Family Archive must distinguish between memory, hypothesis, and documented fact.

2. Principle of Lineal Continuity

A change of surname, place of residence, citizenship, social status, or form of family self-identification does not in itself terminate biological or familial continuity. Lineal continuity is understood as the totality of descent, family memory, names, documents, traditions, symbols, and connections between generations.

The following principles govern the Family Archive:

- ancestral memory shall be preserved, but shall not substitute for historical evidence;
- every primary source discovered shall be entered into the Archive with its provenance, date, and degree of reliability;
- disputed or unconfirmed information shall be identified as a version, tradition, or hypothesis;
- a genealogical connection established by documentary evidence shall take precedence over later family interpretation.

3. The House of Svinar

The designation “House of Svinar” is used to identify the genealogical, familial, and dynastic tradition. It expresses the continuity of the line, its memory, and its internal organization, and does not constitute a claim to state-recognized noble status.

As a sign of the preservation and continuation of the line:

- the modern coat of arms of the House of Svinar is established as its own family heraldic emblem;
- the Seal of the House is instituted with the motto FORTIS ET LIBER — “Strong and Free”;
- the surname Svinar is preserved as the living family name of the present line;
- the office of Keeper of the Lineage is instituted — the person responsible for preserving the Chronicle, the Archive, the symbols, and continuity; since 2025, this office has been held by Vadim of the House of Svinar.

4. Coat of Arms and Symbols of the House

The coat of arms of the House of Svinar was created as an independent modern family symbol. It deliberately does not reproduce the historical arms of the Princes Svirsky and is not used as evidence of legal succession to their title. Its purpose is to express memory, dignity, continuity, and the values of the present line.

- The dark steel-colored shield symbolizes resilience and the ability of the lineage to endure historical change.
- The golden lion rampant symbolizes dignity, courage, mastery of one's own destiny, and remembrance of the asserted princely tradition.
- The winged supporters symbolize guardianship of the lineage and the union of past and future.
- The crown motif has heraldic and commemorative significance and does not in itself constitute a claim to a title recognized by any state.
- The crest with the raised lion signifies the generation that restored and systematized the ancestral memory.
- The motto FORTIS ET LIBER expresses the principle of the lineage: to preserve strength and freedom through generations.
- The concealed marker within the composition is used by the Keeper of the Lineage for the internal identification of the authorized version of the coat of arms.

5. Family Archive and Standard of Evidence

The Chronicle establishes the Family Archive as a system for preserving and verifying materials concerning the origin and history of the House. Each item is assigned a number, date of entry, source, and category of evidentiary weight.

- Category A — primary state, ecclesiastical, notarial, judicial, and archival documents.
- Category B — reliable secondary historical and genealogical publications referring to primary sources.
- Category C — family documents, photographs, letters, objects, and testimonies of established provenance.
- Category D — oral ancestral memory, family traditions, and reconstructions requiring independent verification.

The connection between the present Svinar line and the historical Svirsky family shall be regarded as documented only upon the formation of a sufficient body of sources capable of professionally substantiating such a connection.

6. Legal and Cultural Nature of the Chronicle

The Chronicle is a private family, cultural, historical-archival, and declarative document. It operates within the bounds of applicable law and may not be construed as creating a separate public jurisdiction, granting exemption from the laws of any state, or unilaterally

creating rights that require state registration, judicial determination, or a decision of a competent authority.

The preservation of family identity, name, memory, documents, original texts, and symbols may receive legal protection under laws governing personal non-property rights, private and family life, property, copyright, and other applicable legal institutions. Such protection does not automatically confirm a specific historical descent or title.

The following are taken into account as the relevant legal framework:

- the Constitution of Ukraine — guarantees of dignity, private and family life, freedom of expression, and judicial protection of rights;
- the Civil Code of Ukraine — provisions concerning personal non-property rights, names, civil rights, and remedies for their protection;
- the Family Code of Ukraine — provisions governing family relations, kinship, and the rights of family members;
- Article 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights — the right to respect for private and family life;
- legislation concerning copyright, marks, and other forms of legal protection — insofar as its requirements apply to the original texts, graphics, coat of arms, and designations of the House.

The legal provisions referred to here serve to protect family and cultural identity and the materials created in connection with it; they do not substitute for historical proof of descent.

7. The House of Svinar and the Kingdom of Actarion

Within the tradition of the Kingdom of Actarion, the Chronicle forms part of the heritage of the Royal House and may be preserved in the Royal Archives and published in the ROYAL HOUSE section under the title THE LINEAGE CHRONICLE · HOUSE OF SVINAR.

For Actarion, the Chronicle records the family tradition and the Founder's lineage to the extent that they are supported by sources or clearly identified as family tradition. This distinction forms part of Actarion's archival principle: memory must be preserved, and the degree to which it is proven must be stated with integrity.

8. Preservation, Editions and Continuity

The Chronicle shall be preserved indefinitely as a record of the Family Archive. It may be supplemented by appendices, archival extracts, genealogical tables, images, research findings, and expert opinions.

Each substantial revision shall receive its own date and edition number. New evidence may refine the Chronicle but shall not erase earlier editions: the history of the research itself also forms part of the history of the lineage.

Date of Restoration and Systematisation of the Lineage: 9 May 2025.

Keeper of the Lineage: Vadim of the House of Svinar.

Place of Physical Preparation of the Original Version: Kyiv, Ukraine. The designation of place is purely geographical in nature and does not imply any territorial affiliation of Actarion.

We claim no title belonging to another; we affirm our own responsibility toward those who came before us and those who will come after.

Memory without evidence is tradition. Evidence without memory is an archive. Together, they become history.

Thus it is recorded. Thus it is preserved. Thus it is passed onward.
